As I reflect on the challenges and triumphs of the past year at Quiet Oaks, I find myself inspired by the continued commitment and generosity of our community. We are thankful for a community that supports us not only financially, but with gifts of their time. Hundreds of volunteers show up every day to cook meals, care for residents, clean the house, work in the gardens, mow the lawn, bake cookies and anything else that needs to be done. The work and commitment of our volunteers allow our staff to focus on the mission of Quiet Oaks. By leveraging the talents and resources of our entire community, we have been able to continue serving the families of Central Minnesota. By uniting the passion and commitment of donors, community leaders and volunteers, we are creating a sustainable future that allows our care team to continue focusing on Compassionate Care.

One of the main highlights from this past year is the creation of the Veterans Compassionate Care Fund. We launched this initiative on Memorial Day and announced a very ambitious goal of \$250,000 – which we were able to reach by Veterans Day! While Quiet Oaks has always supported and served Veterans (20% of our residents are Veterans) – this fund creates a safety net for those who have served our country that may not qualify for full benefits or are unable to secure care from a VA approved medical facility. These funds will ensure that all Veterans can receive compassionate care at the end of their life.

### **Our Mission & Vision**

The mission of Quiet Oaks Hospice House is to provide high quality, personalized care, comfort and dignity to our residents and their families in the remaining days of their life together.



#### **Our Values**

**Comfort:** Our resident and their families experience the genuine care and comforts of home; massages, quilts and homemade cookies are all essential elements of care.

**Support:** Quiet Oaks is a community resource, and we do all we can to ensure we are accessible to all.

Care: Our Gold Standard Care provides comfort, support and dignity 24/7 with no exceptions.

Compassion: At Quiet Oaks, residents and their families feel valued, understood and loved.

**Dignity:** We honor and respect each person's right to live each moment of each day as fully as possible. Residents are in charge of their schedule and care on *their* terms.



# **Hospice Goals**

To provide comfort care rather than curative care.

To emphasize quality of life, rather than length of life.

To help patients truly live until they die, without the fear of dying in pain, dying alone or losing control.

To consider the entire family with the focus of care, not just the patient.

To treat the person, not the disease.

Quiet translates to peace. Oaks represent strength. When you enter, may you always be embraced by the peaceful strength that is Quiet Oaks.



# **Hospice Care vs. Respite Care**

### **Hospice Care**

Hospice is a philosophy of care that emphasizes a person's quality of life. Hospice is not about giving up. It is about shifting the focus from cure to quality of life and doing all that can be done to relieve suffering and promote comfort. Residential hospice care enables family members to focus on their loved one and each other, rather than serving as fulltime caregivers. Quiet Oaks Hospice House has been established to meet those needs; providing medical care by qualified, licensed professionals as well as emotional and spiritual support to our residents *and* those who love them. Residents may be admitted at any stage in their hospice journey.

### **Respite Care**

Respite care provides an opportunity for families to take a break from their caregiving responsibilities. The average stay for respite residents is 3-5 days. Respite care offers 24-hour licensed nursing care for an individual and is a trusted solution when family caregivers need to be away.

Quiet Oaks is one of 11 residential hospice houses in Minnesota. While most of our residents are from the Central Minnesota area, we also serve residents and families from the entire state of Minnesota in addition to out-of-state families. Quiet Oaks can offer hospice or respite care to any adult over the age of 18, while honoring all faiths, beliefs and cultural backgrounds.


